





# FAMOUS PLACES


**Cathedral:** Gothic basically building while combining various styles and eras. Built on the place of martyrdom of the saints of the City. .




**Episcopal palace:** Brick building of the 16th to 18th centuries. Next to Cathedral.



**St. Andrew's Church:** Started in s. XVI highlights the magnificent Gothic doorway with a curious tympanum and an interesting interior. In the chorus, splendid picture of the Immaculate Conception.



**Convent of the Discalced Carmelites** (late s. XVI)  
Interior: Christ at the Column, of Gregorio Hernández.



**Santiago's Church:** Neoclassical, with a beautiful porch. Inside, the altarpiece dedicated to Santiago.



**St. Francisco's church.** Located on the ancient acropolis of the city. It houses the processions of Holy Week.



**Shrine or Cruise:** Near the convent of Carmen. Raised at the entrance to the city in memory of the pilgrims.

# MUSEUMS

- ◉ **Diocesan Museum:** located in the cloister of the Cathedral. Inside are art works such as paintings, sculptures,... of churches in other villages uninhabited.
- ◉ **Vegetables Museum:** Museum dedicated to the vegetables and to the orchard.
- ◉ **Romanization Museum:** Exhibition focusing on the pre-Roman, Roman and Christian world who shaped our province and city.
- ◉ **Museum of pasos of Holy Week:** the ancient temple of St. Francisco is home of the pasos that make up the Calahorra's Holy Week.



# TRADITIONAL FOOD

- ◉ Meat: Is typical eat, the lamb offal of La Rioja, the chops to branch, etc.
- ◉ Fish: The cod Rioja style.
- ◉ Vegetables: The garlic soup, potatoes with chorizo or Rioja style. In beans, stress the white beans. It was also made stuffed peppers.

# THE WINTER FESTIVALS


- ◉ The winter Festivals are celebrated in honor of the Saints Emeterio and Celedonio. Usually , this festivals are formed for three days, but there are intense .


# ST. ISIDRO

- ◉ The days of the vegetables, bring together many visitors in search of our vegetables. In this day , carry out events related with the vegetables and the orchard.




# OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

# ST. CATHERINE


